Introduction

Youth Minister is an exciting new role for an inspirational and enthusiastic leader who feels called to share God's love with a new generation in this place, and who can strategically and practically grow and develop our existing youth ministry.

St John's is a lively, spirit filled church where we value growing in faith, being welcoming, loving, prayerful and community focussed. We believe God is doing a new thing here and have a vision to see people come to faith and grow as disciples of Jesus.

Key Responsibilities

Reach *(approximately 40% of the role)*

- With innovation, prayer and vision, develop a strategy to reach out to 11-18 year olds in the local area in a variety of settings
- By utilising strong existing links, and by creating new ones, collaborate with local organisations and schools, and reach young people with an impactful, relational missional ministry

Develop *(approximately 30% of the role)*

- Develop and support our Sunday and midweek ministries
- Use your own gifting, style and leadership to identify and develop priorities and a sustainable plan to build on what already exists and develop both outreach and discipleship
- Monitor, evaluate and review the effectiveness of the work
- Lead, develop and invest in the team of volunteers

Grow *(approximately 30% of the role)*

- Engage in personal development and reflection opportunities
- Seek to grow your own faith
- Lead, encourage and nurture our young people in their faith

How We Will Support You

- You will be supported by the vicar, the staff team and a fantastic team of youth ministry volunteers
- Budget is set aside for your continued professional development
- A support group from within the congregation will uphold you and your ministry
- Encouragement to be involved with youth leader networks
- Support and encouragement from St John's church family

Main Terms

- This is a full-time post of **39 hours per week** which will be arranged around the ministry and will include some evening and weekend work
- Salary **£30,000 -£35,000** depending on experience
- Pension scheme
- St John's Church office is the normal place of work and a desk and computer are provided
- This post holds a genuine occupational requirement that the person appointed is a committed practicing Christian. The Employment (Religion and Belief) Regulations section 7.2 applies. Applicants must have the right to work in the UK.
- Possible housing/relocation allowance. Working expenses reimbursed
- The post holder will be expected to be a full worshipping member of St John's
- The Vicar is the line manager for the post
- Appointment is subject to enhanced DBS checks

- Skilled in creating opportunities for outreach; able to plan and realise vision
- Organised and self-motivated
- An ability to build relationships, team and community. An ability to gather people together

- Excellent IT (Microsoft office suite) and social media skills

- Energetic and enthusiastic




