Essential

- **Practising Christian** committed to the vision and life of the Church of England (GOR).
- **Experience** of leading or supporting children's ministry and helping children to grow in faith.
- **Strong communicator** with children, parents, volunteers and school staff.
- **Volunteer leadership** experience: recruiting, training and supervising volunteers.
- **Safeguarding knowledge** and willingness to complete diocesan training; DBS enhanced clearance required.
- **IT skills** including Microsoft Word, Excel and social media (Instagram/Facebook).
- **Right to work in the UK** and ability to travel independently across the benefice.

Desirable

- Recognised qualification in children's or youth ministry.
- Experience working with schools or community organisations.
- Understanding of the Holy Spirit's role in children's discipleship.
- Experience in budget management and basic reporting.

Other requirements

- Flexible working including Sundays, occasional evenings and school holidays.
