

JOB DESCRIPTION

Children and Youth Minister, Conisbrough Parish

1 GENERAL SCOPE OF RESPONSIBILITIES

The key responsibilities of the role (dependent on experience) are:

- 1.1 to lead and further develop the work with children and youth in the parish of Conisbrough, drawing, developing and discipling a new generation of children and young people in the Christian faith.
- 1.2 to strengthen and support the teams of dedicated volunteers involved in the development and delivery of the work.

2 KEY TASKS

- 2.1 Lead our growing work with toddlers, children and youth, midweek and Sundays, including our monthly All-Together Service called Treasure Chest, Growing Together (babes & tots under 3s), Fuel (KS2-Y5), Ablaze (Y6 to Y11) as well as our Sunday Kids Church (which takes place during our Sunday all-welcome services) and monthly Bubble Church for families with under 5s.
- 2.2 Continue to develop a seamless journey from babies to young adults engaging with us.
- 2.3 Identify skills and talents relevant to children's and youth work, within the congregation, and nurture and develop these gifts, in order to grow the team of volunteers.
- 2.4 Prepare and lead our annual Holiday Bible Club (currently February half-term) with support from the existing team plus any other volunteers.
- 2.5 Maintain the good relationships with our local schools, including leading occasional assemblies and Church visits.
- 2.6 Comply with relevant safeguarding and health and safety guidelines, including ensuring compliance by other leaders and volunteers, and completing appropriate risk assessments.
- 2.7 Report to Revd Martijn Mugge and attend weekly catch-up meetings as well as bi-monthly PCC meetings.
- 2.8 Meet on a regular basis with others involved in Youth and Children's Ministry in the Diocese and ReNew network for learning and support.
- 2.9 Undertake such other duties as may reasonably be required commensurate with the responsibilities of the post.
